

**In English we will learn about:**

**As writers we will be:**

Writing an information Booklet about 'Going for a Woodland Walk'.

**Traditional Rhymes** - A simple rhyme based on a traditional rhyme.

Stories on a theme - A written narrative, based on a film or picture book, with a seaside setting.

**In Science we will learn about:**

What is it like in Spring?

**In PE we will learn about:**

Dance activities: Seaside. To remember, repeat and perform a short dance to represent life in a seaside village.

**In History we will learn about:**

We will be exploring the history of the seaside. From Victorian seaside holidays to Blackpool as a holiday destination.

What people wore at the beach in the past, entertainment from the past and comparing it with the seaside now.

**In Music we will learn about:**

Musical Vocabulary; Under the Sea

Vocal and Body Sounds: By the Sea.

**In PSHE we will be learning about:**

Changing me - understanding that everyone is unique and special. Understanding and respecting changes that we see in ourselves and others.

Dreams and Goals - working hard and having a positive attitude towards ours and others dreams and goals.

**In R.E. we will learn about:**

Ascension and Pentecost:

Learning about Jesus ascending into heaven, looking at God as three in one - Father, Son and Holy Spirit and understanding how the events of Pentecost impact on church today.

The Church:

Understanding that the church is a special place where Christians meet to work and pray. Knowing that the church is a body of people and not just a building.

**In Maths we will learn about:**

Place Value of numbers, including ten more and ten less. Position and Direction, including time. Addition including use of doubles and number bonds to help mental calculations. Measuring including reading scales. Quarters and halves of both shapes and quantities. Naming and classifying both 2D and 3D shapes. Continued use of repeated addition and times tables facts of 2, 5 and 10.

**In Geography we will learn about:**

Simple fieldwork and observation to study the geography of the school and local area.

Creating a 3D map of Darwen across all our classes and fitting it together to show Darwen as it is.

**In DT we will learn about:**

Key parts of a wheeled vehicle, to develop an understanding of how wheels, axles and axle holders work. Design and make a moving vehicle.

**In Art we will learn about:**

Seaside art - Landscapes using different media, including IT.

**In Computing we will learn about:**

Sorting objects to help us answer questions. Children will use technology purposefully to create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve digital content. They will recognise common uses of information technology beyond school
