## Attendance and Punctuality

Persistent absence and lateness will affect a child's achievement and progress in school. Comprehensive research shows that there is a direct link between a child's level of school attendance and their level of school attainment.

As a parent it is your legal responsibility to ensure your child receives a suitable full time education.

It is your responsibility that your child attends school each day and is on time. It is important to set the expectation of good attendance right from the beginning of school so children grow up with 'good habits'. **Children must arrive between 8.45-8.55am. After 8.55am your child will be marked as late.**
