

In English we will learn about Story Writing:

We will be reading the book "Bog Baby " by Jeanne Willis. We will be exploring the text ensuring understanding and using inference and summarising skills. We will then adapt the story using our own ideas. Alongside this we will be learning the grammar, punctuation and spelling

In Maths we will learn about:

Recall of all times tables to 12 x 12
Place value
Written multiplication
Shape and position
Calculation and statistics
Counting and sequencing using statistics and measures
Decimals and fractions using measures

In RE we will learn about: The Church

We will explore similarities and differences between churches worldwide. We will explore where people of other faiths worship.

In Music we will learn about: use a mixture of body percussion to create their own rhythms associated with beginning to learn how to use musical notation and instruments

In ICT we will learn about: Touch Typing

Use IT to create art which includes my own work and that of others. Touch typing, Manipulate and improve digital images, Use technology respectfully and responsibly, Know different ways I can get help if I am concerned.

In Science we will learn about: Plants

Identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants. Explore the requirements of plants for life and growth Record findings using simple scientific language, drawings, labelled diagrams, keys, bar charts and tables Report on findings from enquiries, Investigate the way in which water is transported within plants Explore the part that flowers play in the life cycle of flowering plants, including pollination, seed formation and seed dispersal.

In PE we will learn about: Rounders

Throwing and catching with accuracy
To strike a ball
To apply simple tactics when striking and fielding
To communicate as part of a team.

In Geography we will learn about:

How to locate rainforests on a world map and identify the countries that they are in. How to explain the key aspects of Rainforest climate. How to describe and understand the features of the layers of a rainforest. How to describe plants and animals living in the Rainforest. How to compare the Amazon Rainforest and a forest in our country. How to explain the effects humans are having on the rainforests. **We will also be visiting Blackpool Zoo on Wed 15th June to find out more about Rainforest animals.**
